








Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC)

Though contracting opportunities for small businesses are abundant, cybersecurity poses a threat to small businesses in the defense industrial base and our national security. To help mitigate cybersecurity threats, the Department of Defense (DoD) will soon require small businesses bidding on contracts and performing on current contracts to certify that they meet at least a basic level of cybersecurity standards when responding to solicitations.

The Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC) is a five-level certification process developed by the DoD to help ensure contractors have a system for protecting sensitive data and information.

-  **LEVEL 1:** Demonstrate basic cyber hygiene
-  **LEVEL 2:** Demonstrate intermediate cyber hygiene
-  **LEVEL 3:** Demonstrate good cyber hygiene
-  **LEVEL 4:** Proactive
-  **LEVEL 5:** Advanced/progressive
